

HUDDART COUNTY PARK

Directions

From 280, exit at Woodside Rd. West. Continue on Woodside Rd. past Whisky Hill Rd. and Mountain Home Rd. until Kings Mountain Rd. Turn right on Kings Mountain Rd. Go past Tripp Rd. and Greer Rd. After entering park area turn right on first road (un-named) to "Park Office." Continue to second parking area, to your right, from which there is a large vistas.

Site description

Meeting in the **Second Parking lot** on your right after the ranger station.

Rolling hills with large and distant vistas. It is possible to paint very close to the parking lot, as well as any where you want on the hi.. Typical lovely California landscape, ranges of hills to the horizon, with isolated oak trees and groups of trees and mountains in the distance. A very large range of opportunities for compositions and subject matter from very close to very far. Calm and isolation in nature! Some quite hikers. There are picnic tables and a bathroom facility.

As usual when we are in the country, it is a good idea to protect your legs against eventual insects by wearing long pants, or even better, socks over your pants or boots. Protect you eyes from the general glow with a visor and your skin against the sun. Even on a grey day there is enough reflected light to expose you. Entry fee: \$4.00.
